Carolyn is a consultant botanist and rangeland ecologist in natural resource management. Her passion is integrated natural resource management, particularly in arid areas. She holds a PhD in Rangeland Management.

Carolyn was Chair of the SA Dog Fence Board for four years and a member for twelve, a Sessional Commissioner for the Environment, Resources and Development court of South Australia, and Secretary and a Director of Australian Rangeland Society for eight years. She was also on the SA Pastoral Board for ten years and a member of the SA Arid Lands NRM Board for six years.
